





The Imperial Court System was founded in San Francisco in 1965 by José Julio Sarria, also known as Absolute Empress I, The Widow Norton.

Sarria soon became the nexus of a fundraising group with volunteer members bearing titles of nobility bestowed by yearly elected leaders.

Jose Julio Sarria was the first LGBTQ+ person of color to run for political office in the United States of America. There are now more than 65 courts across the USA, Canada, and Mexico.


